The Aids Village water well is now complete! There has been opposition to this project with natural forces such as rain for several months, also fear and shame from the people, (they are like a leper colony)! But now, by the grace of God, we have been able to complete it! We decided to send teams to the village and demonstrate God's love with clothes, and special gifts for the children and dying adults. Three or more trips were made in the last few months. This is step one in reaching M. Alagapuri village with the gospel. Our next project will be a church building which is already progressing along.

Please continue to pray for this village! The water well is an open door that could cause a spiritual awakening among the villagers who are sitting at death's door. It has brought them hope in a world where their loved ones are dying around them daily. Pray that this hope will bring them to the realization that the God who sent us to put a well in their village loves them more than they could ever know. As you can see on the left, the **first picture of joy on the faces** of these people! In all the other pictures they were sad or depressed. Christ has given them a Christmas gift of water, now let's pray that they will all drink of the water of life. We are believing God for this whole village to come to the Lord. ## Aids Village Water Well Complete!!



In this village, there was no proper water supply. A person had to walk 0.6 miles to fetch water and it was in a very populated area where they do not like sharing it with the affected villagers. The name of the village for our new water well is M. Alagapuri, in the Virudhunagar District of Tamil Nadu, India. The main occupation of this village is making fire works. They make the match sticks and fire crackers in their home and it is collected by a factory person. Even though every one does some sort of work, the wages are very low and is not sufficient for their living. So, the women of this village get involved in prostitution to earn some more money resulting in **85% of this village population being affected by AIDS**. The mortality rate is very high and there are many orphans.

Our native pastor told us the story of a mother that died with Aids. She had no proper treatment or counseling and left her two sons orphaned. These two children are now in the school at 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grade. The teachers and other children look down on these little boys because they are affected with Aids. The two children are not willing to expose their names and identities and are forsaken by their family and society. Because there is no other way, the grandparents are bringing them up. These children get sick very often and the family faces a very difficult time in looking after these kids. **All this tragedy happened because of poverty and a Godless life.**



This is just a story of one family, but there are a number of families suffering in this village with similar problems that are hiding themselves in their hut. Who is there to bring these people out, unless someone like us reaches out to them. There is no church or proper water facility in this village. **A well in this village will help the pastor to share the love of God to these dying people.** Thank you so much for helping us to help them!
